Country Overview



- RMI is an island nation composing of 24 Atoll groups dispersed over 181.43km in the central pacific ocean, located between the Hawaiian islands and the Philippines.
- This poses geographical challenge
- Limited health workforce and centralized health programs limit service delivery to the outer islands (neighboring islands).
- Disease Burdens: NCD among worlds highest as well as TB and Leprosy.
- 74% of all deaths attributed to NCD









Progress Towards Meeting National TB Program Objectives

Mortality-HIV Negative, TB cases, RMI, 2010-2022.

















TB Case Notification (all forms) in the RMI, 2013-2023











Proportion of bacteriologically confirmed Pulmonary TE cases notified (all forms, new and relapse) in RMI, 2013-2023











TB notifications rates (all forms new & relaps by age groups in the RMI, 2013-2023



TB notifications (all forms, new & relapse) by age and sex, RMI, 2023

















TB case notification (all forms, new & recases) RMI, 2013-2022-For outcome an

Successes

- Ongoing ACTIVE CASE FINDING
- -Target testing through TB Mass Screening in Neighboring Islands (TB, Leprosy, NCD component) intergrated-include Immunization, dental services etc.
- -Target testing through public health clinic/TB clearance screening
- Ongoing Contact Investigation
- TB-DM collaboration and expanding NCD program in the community
- Latent TB Infection Treatment (3HP Main Regiment)
- New Fuji (backpack) digital X ray with Computer Assisted Diagnostics
- Clinic Without Walls (CWW just started this year) on Majuro
- TB-Leprosy clinic relocation (clinic and admin office) & New TB Isolation-8 beds, Negative pressure system.
- PH Ship unitized for neighboring islands outreach and TB screening.
- Expanding Internet in maritime & rural areas through Star Link will improve potential for Tele-medicine consultaions













Challenges

- Lack of Man power (human resources for health-all cadre)
- DOT in the Neighboring Islands (28 days rotation) with 2 staff at a time)-9 months
- Geographical challenges
- Inflation
- TB-DM burden, CKD-5 (adverse outcomes) & driver of mortality
- Some patients with Adverse Reaction (more attention to side affects management)
- Lag in adopting new guidance (WHO etc.) National Guidelines for review-TB & Leprosy


